

HOW TO MEASURE YOUR FRIDGE OR FREEZER DOOR SEAL

A step-by-step guide to getting the perfect fit — every time



IMPORTANT DISCLAIMER: Measure carefully before ordering. An incorrect measurement means the seal will not fit. Summit Air & Refrigeration accepts no responsibility for seals cut to measurements supplied by the customer. If you are unsure, contact us before ordering — we are happy to help.

What You Will Need

Before you start, have the following on hand:

- A flexible tape measure — cloth or plastic (not a rigid steel ruler)
- A pen and paper, or your phone to record the measurements
- Your fridge or freezer model number (usually on a label inside the door frame)
- A helper, for larger commercial units



A dressmaker's or soft tape measure works best — it follows curved door frames more accurately than metal tape.

Open the Door Fully

Open your fridge or freezer door all the way so it lies flat. Locate the rubber door seal (gasket) — the flexible rubber strip running around the inside edge of the door frame. This is what you will be replacing.



On a two-door fridge (top or bottom freezer), each door has its own separate seal — measure them independently.

Measure the Width

Measure the **INSIDE** width of the door opening — from the inner edge of the seal groove on the left side to the inner edge on the right side. This is the interior cavity width.

Do NOT measure the outside width of the door itself — this will give you the wrong dimension.



Measure in millimetres (mm) for the most accurate result. Write it down as: Width = ___ mm

3 Measure the Height

Measure the INSIDE height of the door opening — from the inner top edge of the seal groove down to the inner bottom edge. Again, measure the inside of the opening, not the full outer door height.

💡 Write it down as: Height = ___ mm

4 Measure Twice — Order Once

Always measure twice and record both readings before placing your order. If both readings match, you can be confident in your measurement. If they differ by more than 2–3 mm, measure a third time to confirm.

5 Find Your Brand & Model Number

Check inside the fridge on the wall panel, or along the door frame edge, for a label showing the brand name and model number. This helps us confirm the correct seal for your unit without needing custom measurements.

Common label locations:


- Left-side interior wall of the fridge
- Top of the fridge interior, near the light
- Inside the door hinge area or kick plate at the bottom

6 Take Photos (Highly Recommended)

Photograph your fridge or freezer with the door open, and take a close-up of the existing door seal. A photo of the seal profile cross-section is especially helpful for custom or commercial orders.

You can upload photos directly on our product page when placing a custom order — this helps us ensure the perfect fit.

 For commercial units (Skope, Bromic, True, Turbo Air): also photograph any branding or model number on the unit.

Pro Tips for Accurate Measurements

 Measure Twice	Always measure twice and record both readings before placing your order.
 RoomTemp	Rubber seals can shrink slightly when cold — measure when the unit is at room temperature for the most accurate reading.
 InsideNot Outside	Always measure the inside of the opening (the groove the seal sits in), not the outside dimensions of the door.
 Check AllFour Sides	On some models the top/bottom dimensions differ from the left/right. Measure all four sides to be safe.
 Use OldSeal Info	Lay your old seal flat and photograph it next to a ruler — this helps identify the profile type for a replacement.
